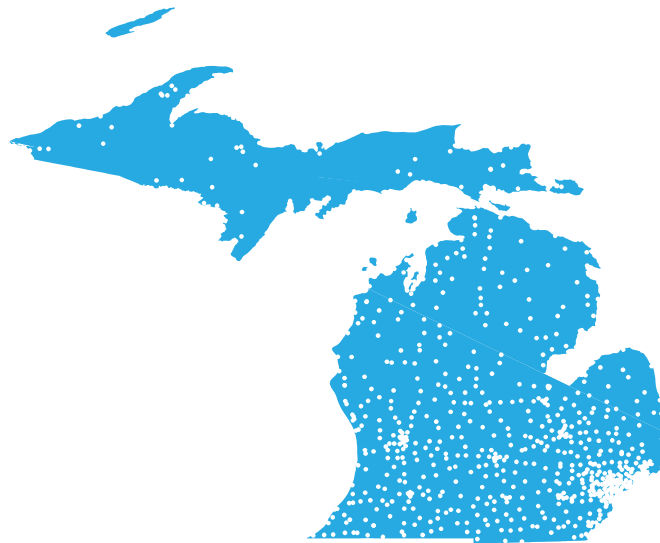


# DID YOU KNOW?

- 94% of Michigan libraries offer access to online job and employment resources
- 94% of Michigan libraries provide access to online homework assistance
- 97% of Michigan libraries provide access to E-books
